We were honored to be able to serve 225 men and women dinner Wednesday evening, December 9th at the shelter located on Massachusetts Avenue in Boston's South End.

Founded in 1987, the Friends of Boston's Homeless is a 501(C)(3) non profit corporation that works in partnership with the Homeless Services of the Boston Public Health Commission to develop and fund innovative, solution-oriented programs to help the homeless move beyond the shelter and back into the community as independent citizens. In addition, through advocacy and education, the Friends seek to increase the public's awareness and understanding of the realities of homelessness.

The Homeless Services network provides basic shelter (bed, shower, food), comprehensive supportive services (health and mental health care, case management, substance abuse treatment and counseling), and, in partnership with Friends of Boston's Homeless, transitional programs like job training and employment services, adult education and literacy, life skills development, and transitional and permanent affordable housing. Shelters associated with Homeless Services include Long Island Shelter (located in Boston Harbor) and Woods Mullen Shelter in the South End.
